WHEN TEACHING YOUR CHILDREN ABOUT SUKKOT



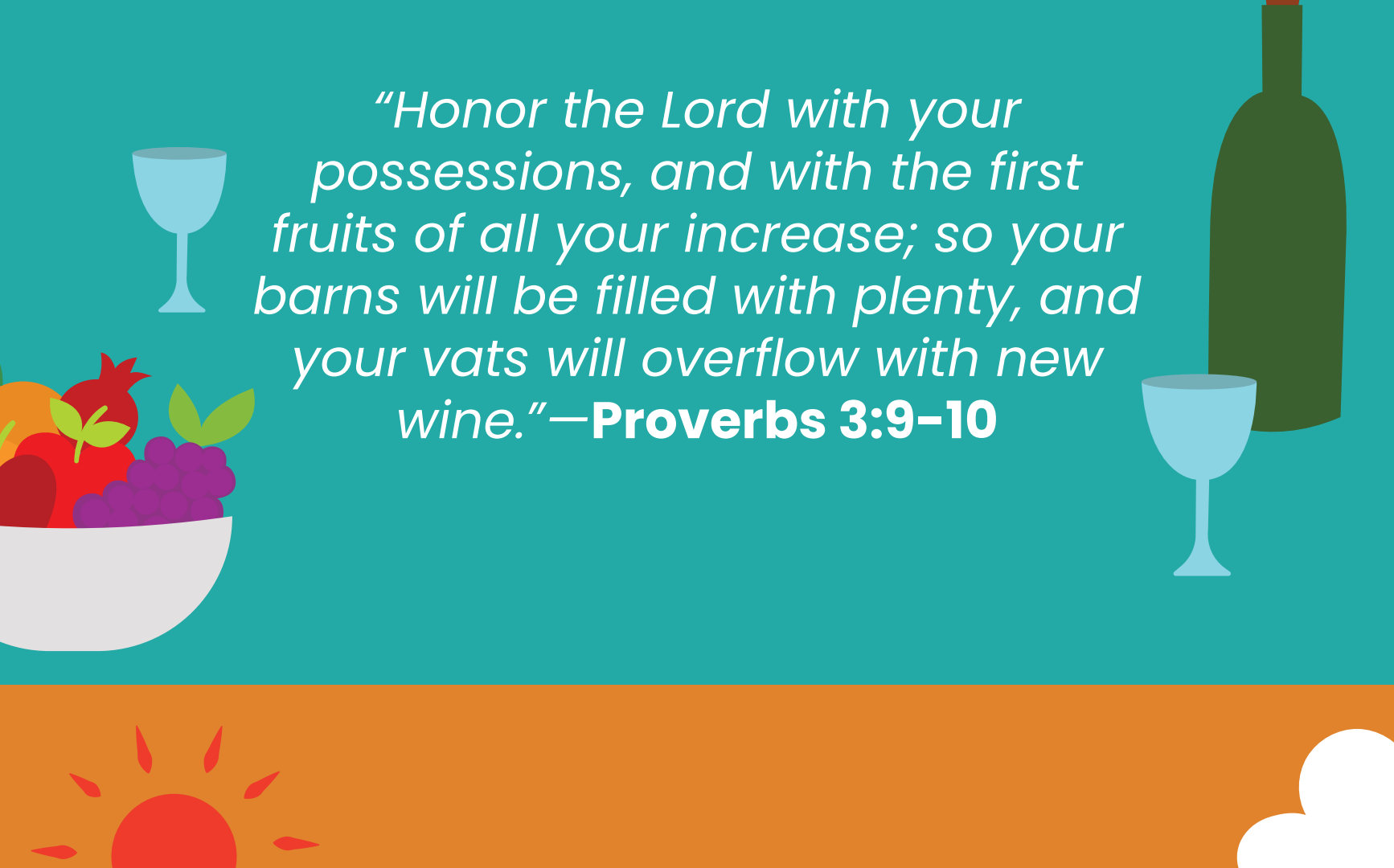
Below are scriptures you can write down, speak, and pray as a family to help your children experience the goodness, as well as the importance of Sukkot.



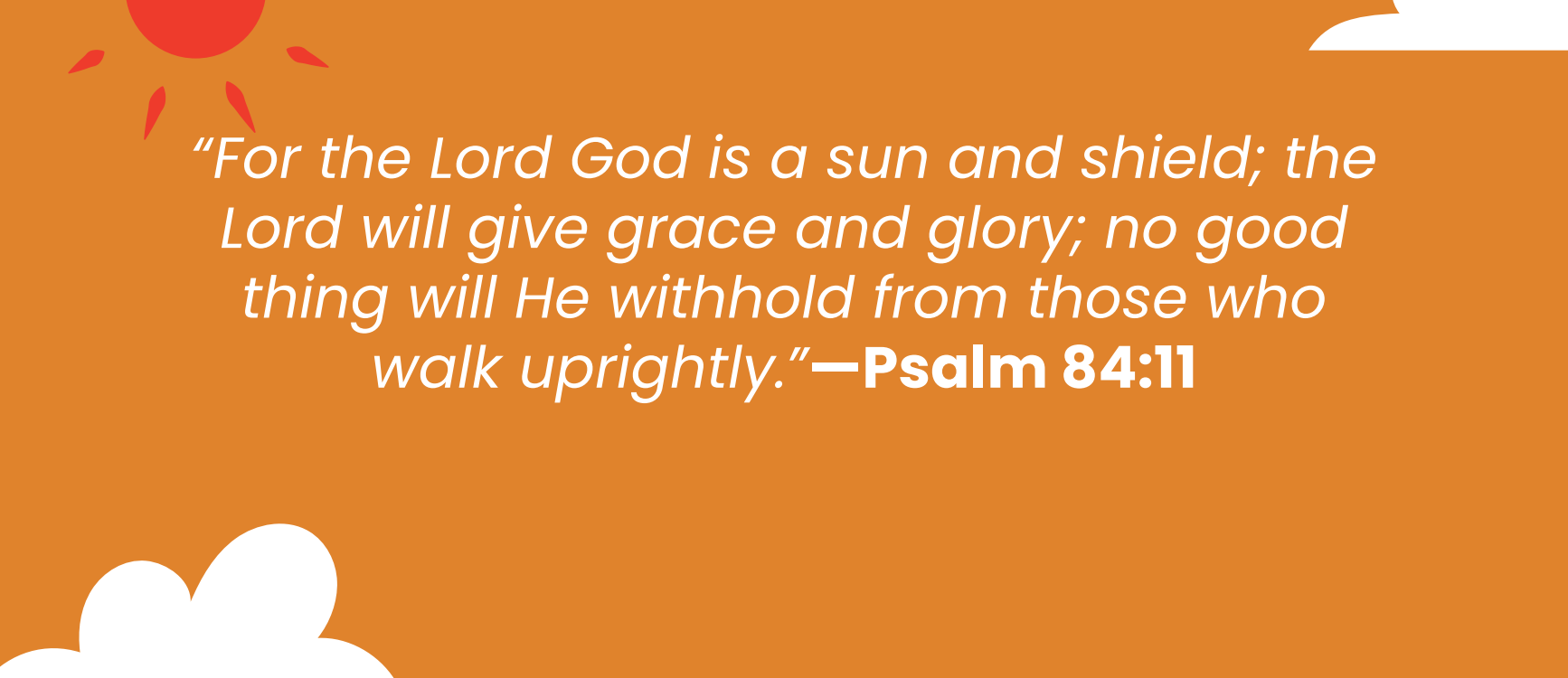
"For the Lord will be your confidence, and will keep your foot from being caught."—**Proverbs 3:26**



"Surely goodness and mercy shall follow me all the days of my life; and I will dwell in the house of the Lord forever."—**Psalms 23:6**



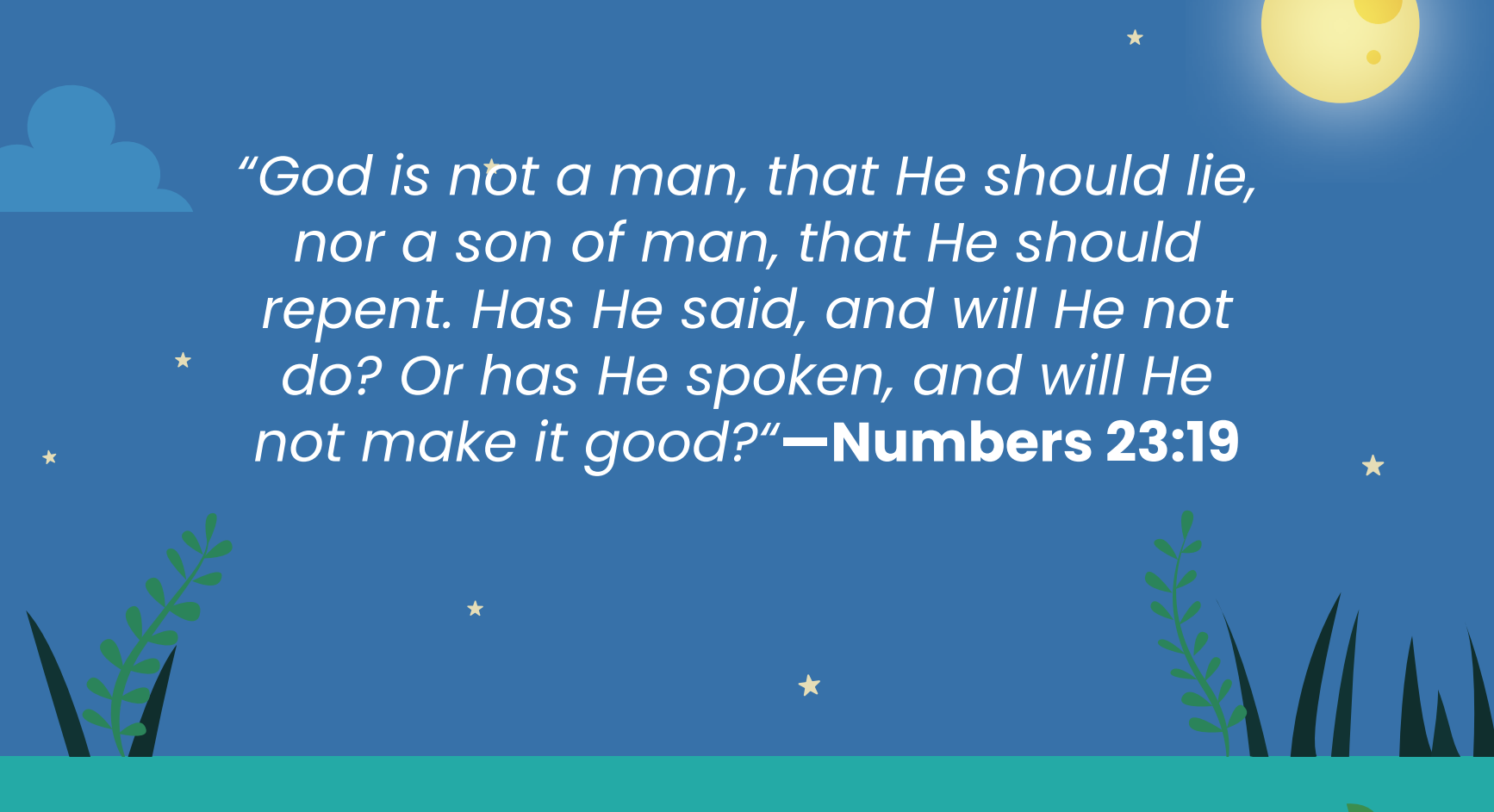

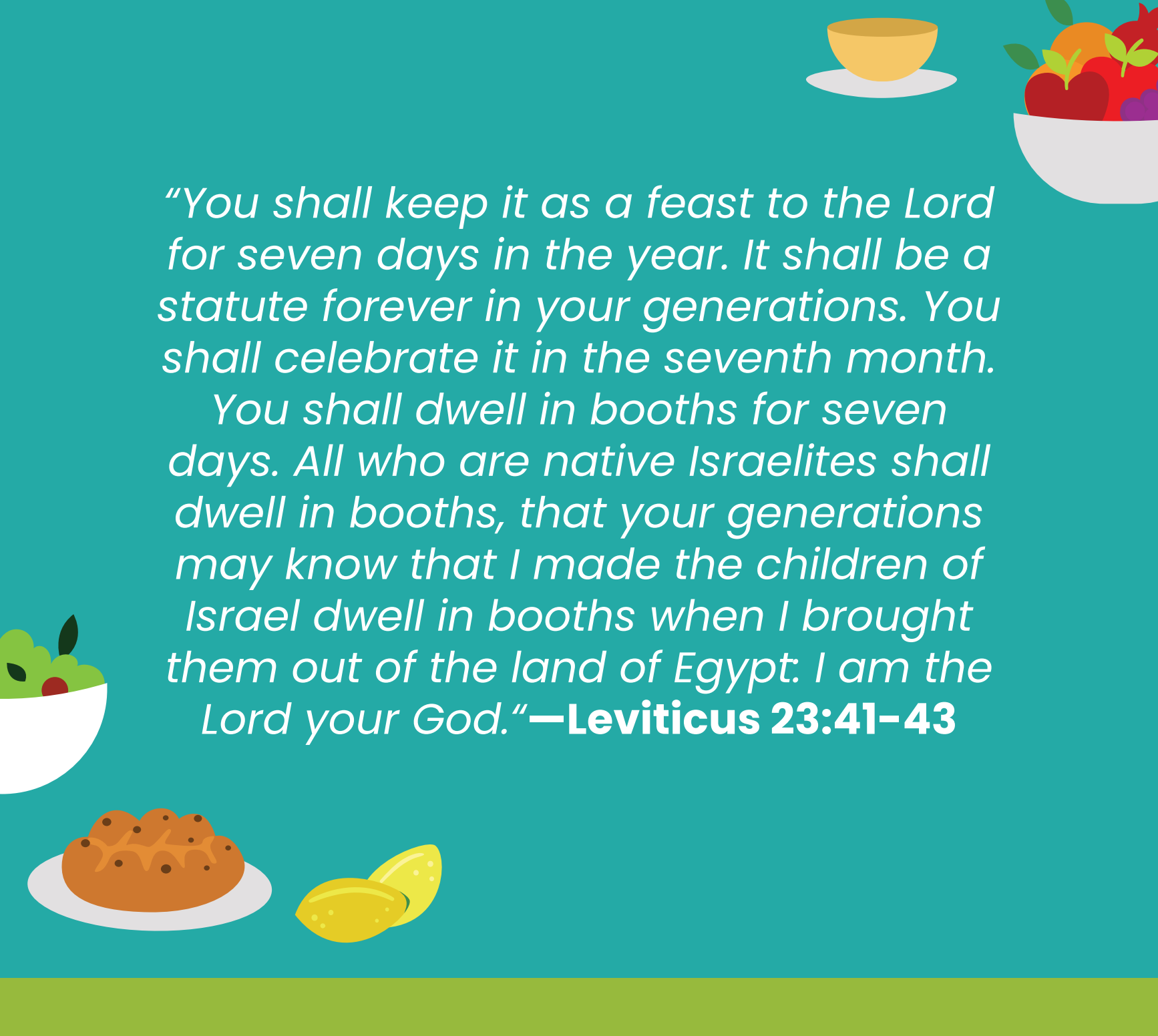
"For the Lord God is a sun and shield; the Lord will give grace and glory; no good thing will He withhold from those who walk uprightly."—**Psalms 84:11**
